## 2025 SDSU Undergraduate RSCA Program (SURP)-match -Student Application

The SDSU Undergraduate Research, Scholarship, and Creative Activities (RSCA) Program (SURP) promotes, broadens, and supports the participation of undergraduate students in research, scholarship, creative, and performance activities at SDSU. If you already have a mentor, who has submitted an application with you in mind, you do not need to complete this application.

## **SURP-match**

- For students who do not have a RSCA mentor
- For students who want to get involved in RSCA
- SURP-match facilitates mentor-mentee pairing
- Experience is not required for every project

## **SURP-match process**

- Application material: 1) brief information about yourself; 2) note the projects you are interested in; 3) brief description of your interest in RSCA; 4) 1-2 page CV/Resume.
- Mentors may reach out to you at any point during the application period (April 21-May 9, 2025). You can find more information about the program, timeline, and expectations on the <u>SURP website</u>.
- Only one application is accepted per SDSU student and you must use your SDSU email address.

Information about available projects will be listed on the 2025 SURP-match projects.

## **SURP student eligibility**

- Undergraduate students enrolled in a degree-seeking program at SDSU (with a graduation date after December 2025).
- Students must be available to participate during the SURP period, which will vary based on project. <u>View anticipated SURP dates</u> by track and 2025 university holiday schedule.
